## TOILET PROBLEMS CONTINUE

We have had issues with several toilets recently being stopped up or overflowing. Sometimes the maintenance department cannot get to residents that day due to weather or it may happen on the weekend. **Residents need to have a plunger in your unit and know where your shut-off valve is for your toilet and sinks.**

Every toilet has a water line under the tank that leads to the silver oval shut-off valve. When turned to the **right or clock wise**, this turns **off** the water to the toilet, in case it should overflow.



The same with your sink, although these valves may be red or silver; there will be a water line that leads from the faucet to a shut off valve or maybe even two valves (one hot/one cold).

Once you have plunged or corrected the problem, turn the valve back to the left, the water will come back on. Then flush to see if your problem has corrected itself.

**IMPORTANT:** If your toilet is clogged due to flushing any of the items listed below or any object that clearly is not flushable, you will be charged for the labor and any damage this may have caused.
